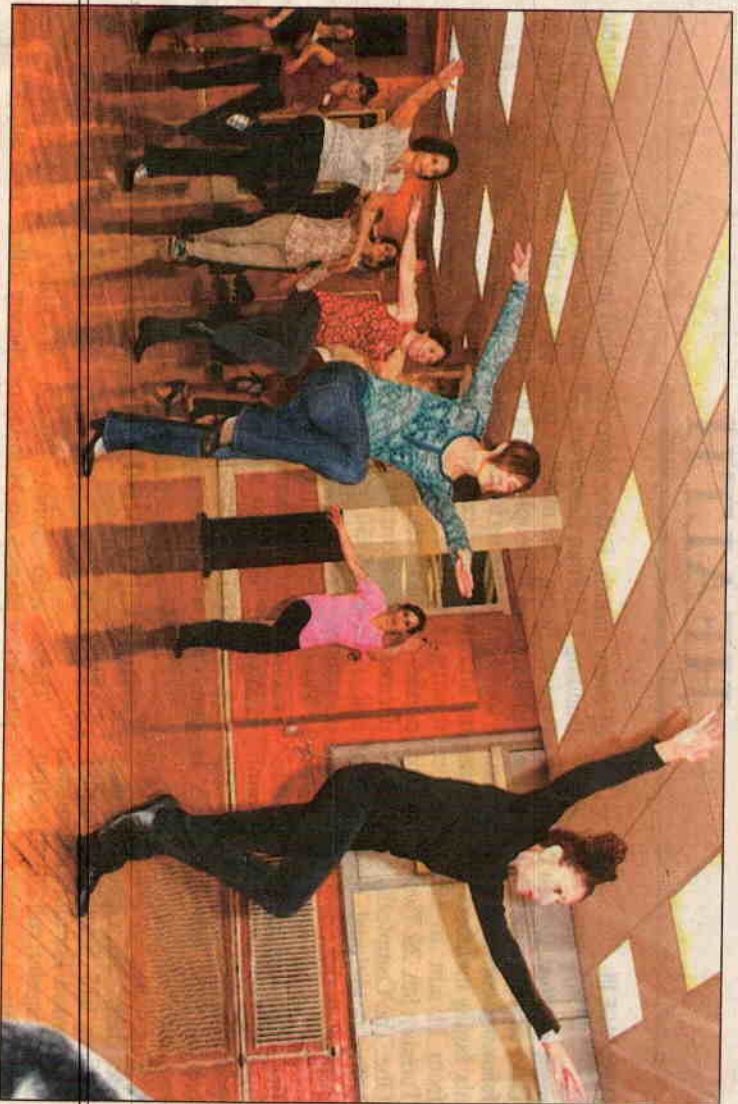

Jamboree 2013 rehearsals under way
